Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

#### What a blessing!

Thank you to all of you who have prayed for me, encouraged me, offered to help, and in so many other ways have stood by my side over the past 6 weeks during my two medical situations. So many of you have offered words of encouragement that it is risky to identify any individuals or groups in particular. However, I must take that risk in order to thank our Elders for stepping up and assisting in worship. On short notice they handled the entire liturgy allowing me to rest in order to be able to conduct those portions of the service that must be done by the pastor. Also, I have received many cards from our Praying in Color team. The hand-written notes, indicating that the author was praying while coloring the beautiful cards, were a wonderful blessing. I understand, now, why Holy Lamb receives so many heartfelt notes of thanks from the recipients of these cards.

I am recovering from my pulmonary embolism, but this takes time. This is my third PE, so I am familiar with the process. I thank all of you for understanding that I have not been able to conduct Bible studies and visits as usual. I hope to return to a normal schedule within another week or so. Singing on Sunday mornings will be the last thing to return since singing places such a large demand on the lungs.

I also want to extend my thanks for the many Christmas cards and gifts you have so generously showered on us. The sentiments expressed in the cards, the wonderful foods, and the monetary gifts are all greatly appreciated. What a joy and blessing it is to serve such a loving congregation!

Of course, we will soon be into the season of Lent. I am especially excited about our midweek services this year. When Kathy and I were in Wittenberg, we saw a painting in the church where Luther did much of his preaching. It was actually finished after his death; but in the series of paintings above the Altar, Lucas Cranach the Elder, visually proclaimed the Gospel as Luther had come to understand and teach it. It is a beautiful and wonderfully explicit series of paintings; and our midweek services will examine them for the unique manner in which they proclaim the truth of God's love and work through Jesus Christ. Please plan to join us for these 7:00 services on Wednesday evenings beginning on Ash Wednesday, February 26<sup>th</sup>.

Finally, on February 7<sup>th</sup>, Holy Lamb is holding a Spaghetti Dinner to raise funds for hurricane relief in Puerto Rico. Even though it has been over 2 years since hurricane Maria hit as a Category 5, many homes have only a blue tarp for a roof. They can even be seen on a Google Maps image. Hope Lutheran Church in Wake Forest is assembling 4 mission trips this year to install steel roofs on these homes. We have been invited to participate in this ministry through a physical presence, on-site, for the repairs, and/or by helping with costs associated with the repairs. The Spaghetti Dinner addresses the funding issue. If you would like to make a one-week trip to Puerto Rico to assist in the rebuilding, please contact me for information. This is a great opportunity to put many of our individual and collective resources to work for Gods' purposes.

## Adult Bible Study ~ Current Bible Study Opportunities

### **Sunday Morning Bible Study**

We will look at all three of the lessons of the day, considering perspectives not included in the sermon. This study enhances our worship by providing additional background for the lessons and a deeper meaning for the sermon.

#### **Tuesday Morning Bible Study Hebrews** 9:00 AM

Hebrews was written to a Jewish Christian congregation as a sermon to be read in worship. The author describes the letter as a word of encouragement. He shows Jesus Christ to be our great High Priest, the greater Moses, the fulfillment of Old Testament prophesies, the sacrifice for the world's sins. This revelation encourages us, strengthens our faith, and increases our confidence in the One True God.

## Wednesday Evening Bible Study

## Grace, Faith, Scripture: Portrait of a Lutheran

'Grace Alone', 'Faith Alone', 'Scripture Alone' have long been used to characterize the unique theology of the Lutheran faith. These 'solas' (alone) set up a relationship between God and us and between us and our neighbor.

Using stories and situations drawn from common relationships such as friendships and marriage, we will see how the three 'solas' bring God's Word to life and are evidenced in our daily lives.
