At the same time others are, indeed, feeling more like Job. To you I offer the encouragement of patience and trust. All of the blessings listed previously have come after a time of prayer in the midst of struggle. If this is where you are, relish the opportunity to be in prayer, confide deeply in your Creator, and rejoice in the surety of your forgiveness and eternal life in heaven.
