## Behold the Lamb of God: A Holy Week Reflection

Spring is in full bloom here in Myrtle Beach, and with it comes the promise of new life. The warmer air, the budding flowers, and the longer days remind us of renewal and hope. But even greater than the joys of spring is the joy of celebrating my first Easter with you here at Holy Lamb Lutheran Church.

As we approach Holy Week, we walk through the very heart of our Christian faith—a journey from the Upper Room to the Empty Tomb. It is a time when we remember and confess, through the words of the Apostles' Creed, what Jesus Christ has done for us:

"I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell. The third day He rose again from the dead."

On Maundy Thursday, we gather to remember the night when Jesus gave His disciples—and us—the gift of the Lord's Supper. As He shared the bread and the cup, He proclaimed, "This is My body, given for you... This is My blood, shed for you for the forgiveness of sins." In this holy meal, we continue to receive the very gifts of His sacrifice: His true body and blood, given for our salvation.

On **Good Friday**, we stand at the foot of the cross. We hear the somber words, "It is finished." The sinless Lamb of God, whom John the Baptist pointed to, has taken away the sins of the world. Jesus bore the full weight of our guilt, our shame, and our punishment. He was crucified, died, and was buried. But we know that this is not the end.

On **Holy Saturday**, we reflect on the mystery of Christ's descent into hell—not in defeat, but in triumph. As we confess in the Creed, Jesus "descended into hell," not to suffer further, but to proclaim His victory over sin, death, and the devil.

And then, on Easter Sunday, we rejoice! The tomb is empty! The stone is rolled away! Christ has risen! "The third day He rose again from the dead." His resurrection is the confirmation that sin is forgiven, death is defeated, and eternal life is ours in Him.

This **Holy Week**, let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the Lamb of God who was slain and who now reigns forever. Through His death and resurrection, He has made us His own. I am honored to celebrate this Easter with you, and I pray that the joy of the risen Christ fills your hearts and homes.

#### He is risen! He is risen indeed! Alleluia!

The cost is \$40.00.


